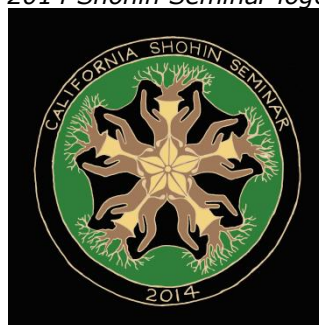
Darren and Laura Wong sent the following pictures of the Azalea material that will be used for their workshop. Very nice trees !
